Here is a guide to help new parents (and experienced ones) with ordering textbooks for Year 7 2021

Year 7 Textbooks	Extra information
Compulsory Digital Resources	The first item on the booklist is the 'Compulsory Digital Resources' bundle. This includes the digital products that students will access for Religious Education, their Language choice, the Project Based Learning resource Echo, and the Science resource STILE. The bundle is a compulsory purchase. The school will work with students to register and access the resources.
Art and Design SJC Visual Art Diary	Compulsory item. To be distributed in class.
Chinese Learn Chinese Learn Culture Book 1 (Zhang) Language Perfect	This book must be purchased through Champion. It cannot be purchased second hand as it contains workbook exercises. Language Perfect is a digital tool for students studying languages. The price is included in the <i>Compulsory Digital Resources</i> bundle.
English Collins Australian Compact Dictionary 7E (H/B) Detention (P/B) [Bancks] Black Cockatoo (P/B) [Merrison and Hustler]	This is the recommended dictionary and it is retained until Year 12. Other editions can be used. A comparable dictionary is acceptable. <i>Detention</i> and <i>Black Cockatoo</i> are the Year 7 novels. They are new for 2021. Second hand copies are acceptable.
Health and Physical Education Nelson VIC Fit for Life! HPE 7 & 8 Student Book (2 Yr Access Code)	This is a new edition for 2021 and cannot be purchased second hand. Do not access the digital component. This will be done in class.
Humanities Oxford Big Ideas VIC Humanities print and digital	This is a hard copy textbook (with an access code on inside cover for an etextbook). It may be purchased second hand. Do not access the digital component. This will be done in class.
Italian Italian Workbook to be purchased from Champion Language Perfect	This must be purchased through Champion. It is an SJC produced workbook and must be purchased new. Language Perfect is a digital tool for students studying languages. The price is included in the <i>Compulsory Digital Resources</i> bundle.

If the textbook is purchase second hand the activation code for the digital resource must be valid. Textbook codes can be checked for validation at https://www.cambridge.edu.au/codecheck/ If the code is not valid in the second hand text a reactivation code must be purchased.</p> <p>This is the recommended calculator that will be used for Year 7-9. If students are continuing with Maths in the VCE a new calculator will need to be purchased in Year 10.</p>
<p>Music Musicianship & Aural Training Level 1 Student Book (2nd Edn) [Smith]</p> <p>Earphones stereo ultra lightweight with adapter</p>	<p>This is a hard copy book. It must be purchased new as it is a workbook.</p> <p>This is a compulsory second set of earphones that will be kept in the music room for the semester.</p>
<p>Religious Education Bible YOUCAT edn</p> <p>Digital St Josephs To Know Worship & Love 7 (Access Code only)</p> <p>St Joseph's College Geelong Journal</p>	<p>This Bible is retained until Year 12.</p> <p>The price for this compulsory text is included in the <i>Compulsory Digital Resources</i> bundle.</p> <p>This is a journal for students that will be used throughout their time at SJC.</p>
<p>Science STILE Digital Resource</p>	<p>Students will not be using a hard copy text for Science. STILE is a digital tool for students studying Science. The price is included in the <i>Compulsory Digital Resources</i> bundle.</p>
